On April 24, 2020, this appeal was dismissed for the failure to comply with this Court's order dated March 11, 2020. "[S]ince it is important for lawyers and self-represented litigants appearing before the Appellate Courts to have time to take actions to protect themselves and their families, the due dates for all Appellate Court filings due on or after the effective date of this order are hereby extended for twenty (20) days." RE: Operation of the Appellate Courts During the Coronavirus Emergency (S.C. Sup. Ct. Order dated March 20, 2020). By operation of the Supreme Court's March 20, 2020 order, the timelines for compliance with this Court's March 11, 2020 order should have been extended for an additional 20 days. Accordingly, this appeal is reinstated. The appellant must provide the notice of appeal filing fee within 20 days of this Court's order, or the appeal will again be dismissed.
