the undersigned counsel's office was closed for several weeks due to the environment's inadvertent exposure to Covid-19 and the disinfection of that environment;


2. Prior to filing this Motion, the undersigned counsel consulted with counsel for Respondent, who has graciously consented to the enlargement herein requested; and,


