3. Appellant is acting pro se due to him being in detention and being in detention for 34 months plus. Therefore he is

not a lawyer and being in detention he does not ~~the~~ <sup>have the</sup> legal access to books and information need to preform all tasks given to him.

4. Appellant is at the mercy of the state because he is at a handicap in his defense in all his cases. Mainly due to a unconstitutional bond condition which has ~~keep~~ kept him in detention and is being used to keep the Appellant at a handicap.

A) Evidence was withheld in my criminal defense so I could not use in my and my mother's Forfeiture hearing "videos of the stop". Can not afford to pay for a lawyer in forfeiture case.

Please excuse my handicap on working to do the work needed to ~~to~~ be done, because as I said many ~~times~~ times before that I can not preform all tasks asked of me. I don't have the money on hand to buy these cheap pins that don't last and the other price hiked things needed like paper, pins, an envelopes. Canteen comes on wensdays and some time my family who is trying to deal with their bills can only send me money when they come. Therefore sending out 24 letters when the detention center only give 6 envelopes a week and a pen once a month" which only last for about 8

pages. Please take notice, that i'm a bi-polar and schizophrenia person and with out the help of legal counsel am pro se. Also the fact that I'm in detention and have been here for almost 3 years and have not been to trial. I can not express enough that i'm handicap in this legal matter going up against well able legal lawyer who have been to school for law. It's a unfair battle at which the courts are making it harder for me by faulting me for every little thing and then impose time limits on me to complete things that I really don't have a clue on how to do and I don't get the mail on time so that I can do so. It's unfair justice and a bullying of the handicap. Thank You.
