MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF

Counsel for James William respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for James Williams respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Devatee Clinton v. The State on March 3, 2020 with the Supreme Court. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Terry Cooper v. The State on February 3, 2020 with the Supreme Court.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request via electronic mail
