Dear Counsel:

The Court is in receipt of a pro se notice of appeal, filed by your client, Herbert Demond York. Pursuant to Rule 264, SCACR, you are still considered counsel of record until relieved by order of the Court.

Upon reviewing your client's pro se notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the title should reflect the title used in the general sessions order and does not list counsel for the respondent.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by a redacted copy of the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.

- Since this is an appeal from a guilty plea, nolo contendere plea, or plea pursuant to Alford, Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iv) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules requires "a written explanation showing that there is an issue which can be reviewed on appeal. This explanation should identify the issue(s) to be raised on appeal and the factual basis for the issue(s) including how the issue(s) was raised below and the ruling of the lower court on that issue(s). If an issue was not raised to and ruled on by the lower court, the explanation shall include argument and citation to legal authority showing how this issue can be reviewed on appeal."
- A proof of service has not been provided showing the notice of appeal has been timely served upon the respondent. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
