soon as practicable. Thank You,

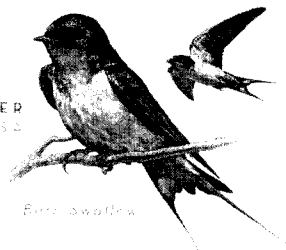
