RE: Notice of intent to name Court and individual justices in Federal suit.

Ms. Abbott Kitchings,

I have included a copy of this letter for each of the judges listed above as well as four additional copies to file with appeals involving me in the SC Court of Appeals. Please ensure the copies are distributed and filed as indicated.

Additionally, you will notice the judge's attorney, at least for now, Mr. Wilson, is also copied.

Based on the extended pattern of misconduct in Charleston County related to cases 2014-CP-10-05407 and 2017-CP-10-04031, which correlates to appeals 2018-000056 and 2018-000174, and this court's own misconduct related to those appeals to protect Scarborough, Charleston County and others from being properly held accountable for their misconduct, this letter is intended to notify you that I believe sufficient evidence exists to also name this court, and multiple judges of this court, in a Federal suit involving Scarborough and Charleston County. I imagine the only true surprise anyone will have related to this notification is that some Person is finally taking any action at all to begin effectively dealing with the corrupt shambles this State's judicial system is.

The situation reminds me, in a perverted manner, of the concept of he who is without sin cast the first stone. Meaning, it appears as if there isn't a single member of the SC Judiciary or SC State BAR sufficiently uncompromised to be able to even minimally perform as is required by the concept of self-governance and / or the Code of Judicial Conduct.

I would also caution all, before publicly declaring me crazy, to take a moment and reflect on the numerous opportunities the legal industry in our State has had to do something that minimally appears to resemble self-governance, and then willfully has covered its eyes and ears to make the case that it didn't know such misconduct was routinely occurring and consequently, had no reason to inquire or take action. Willful ignorance of misconduct is, by its very nature, misconduct.

Mr. McCoy, who is ironically now the Acting US Attorney, Ms. Norrell and Mr. Rankin of the House and Senate Judiciary Committees respectively, are also copied. A copy of the complaint and evidence will be provided to Mr. McCoy in his new position to assess for action through the Department of Justice, obviously the most proper venue to expediently and fully address the underlying issues via Federal law. Hopefully, some subset of people whose responsibility it is to fix this mess will take the opportunity between now and the filing to start taking the numerous and obvious corrective actions necessary to start bringing our State's judicial system back into something that minimally resembles fair, competent and honest.

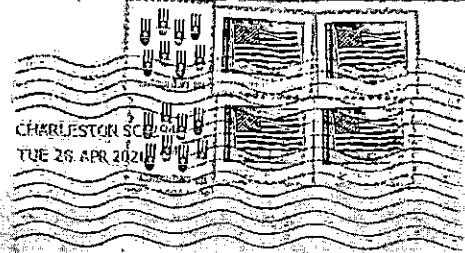
