ORDER

This matter is before the Court on a petition for a writ of certiorari following the denial of petitioner's fifth application for post-conviction relief.

Petitioner's counsel asserts that the petition is without merit and requests permission to withdraw from further representation. Petitioner has filed a *pro se* petition.

After careful consideration of the entire record as required by *Johnson v. State*, 294 S.C. 310, 364 S.E.2d 201 (1988), we deny the petition and grant counsel's request to withdraw.

Moreover, we hereby prohibit petitioner from filing any further collateral actions in the circuit court challenging his murder conviction without first obtaining permission from this Court to do so.
