In response to The South Carolina Court of Appeals letter to me dated March 30, 2020 and post marked March 30, 2020, I did not receive this letter until April 28 that was transferred to me from my P.O. Box on April 23, 2020. Clearly this letter was held on someone's desk/at the Columbia's post office in light of the COVID-9 crisis. I responded immediately to the courts and the courts returned my call immediately and asked that I address this situation.

As I stated to the representative of the Court that contacted me on April 28, to date I still have not received the transcript that I paid for on December 16 2019. Mrs. Kelly, told me via phone conversation, she had been exposed to the Coro-Virus and was not doing well and had retired – certainly I had no reason to believe the Courts would not be aware of this situation. Shortly afterward, the entire State was shut down. Therefore, I suspected to hear from the Courts shortly. However, the Courts appears to be totally unaware of all of this communications???

Therefore, I am requesting and extension in light of Covid-19.
