

## ORDER

Following her municipal court convictions for violations of various city ordinances, Respondent filed an application for post-conviction relief (PCR). In response to the PCR court's grant of relief, the State filed a petition for a writ of certiorari. This Court granted the State's petition, dispensed with further briefing, and reversed the PCR court's decision. *Assa'ad-Faltas v. State*, Op. No. 2020-MO-004 (S.C. Sup. Ct. filed Feb. 19, 2020). Respondent has filed a petition for rehearing. The petition is denied.
