ORDER

Petitioner moves to supplement the Appendix in this matter. Respondent moves to strike the Appendix and require Petitioner to serve and file an amended Appendix that complies with Rule 243(f), SCACR, and to hold the time limits for filing its return to the petition for a writ of certiorari in abeyance pending Petitioner's service of a proper Appendix.

Petitioner's motion to supplement the Appendix with the report from the Midlands Multi-Disciplinary Accident Investigation Team Report is granted; however, the request to supplement the record with a table of authorities is denied.

Respondent's motion to strike the Appendix is granted as to a letter from Petitioner's appellate attorney found on pages 1265–66 of the Appendix, and the record on appeal from an unrelated matter found on pages 1307–24 of the Appendix. Respondent's motion to strike Petitioner's *pro se* motion to alter or amend the judgment and the sworn statement of the Honorable R. Knox McMahon is denied.¹

¹ We note that while Respondent asserts Petitioner's *pro se* motion to alter or amend the judgment was struck from the record, that assertion is not supported by the record. Further, Respondent erred in informing the Court that the statement from the Honorable R. Knox McMahon was not presented to the PCR court when it was stipulated to be incorporated by reference in the record without objection.

Respondent's request that Petitioner be required to supplement the Appendix with pages 467–78 and 501–614 of the trial court transcript is granted. In addition, we grant Respondent's motion to hold this matter in abeyance and order Petitioner to serve and file an amended Appendix, which complies with this order, within twenty (20) days from the date of this order. Respondent shall have thirty (30) days after service of the amended Appendix in which to serve and file its return.
