

ORDER

After careful consideration, Respondent's motion to strike exhibits attached to Appellant's initial brief and motion to strike two documents from Appellant's designation of matter are granted. Appellant's exhibits E and F, which include Daily Alternate Diet Roster information, shall not be included in the record on appeal because they were not presented to the lower court. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record shall not . . . include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal.").
