


ORDER

Petitioner has filed a "Notice of Supplemental Authority" that the Court construed as a motion to supplement the Record on Appeal. The State opposes the motion, but requests that, should the Court grant the motion, the State be allowed to designate additional supplemental materials to be included in the Record on Appeal. Petitioner's motion to supplement the Record on Appeal is granted. The State's request to designate additional supplemental materials to be included in the Record on Appeal is also granted. All supplemental materials must be served and filed with the Court within five (5) days of the date of this order.
