Respondents filed a Motion to Dismiss on May 1, 2020. Appellants filed their Initial Brief and Designation of Matter, along with a Motion to File out of Time, on May 5, 2020. The issues addressed in both motions have been fully briefed.

The Supreme Court's Order of May 29, 2020 effectively granted Appellants' Motion.
