

ORDER


Respondent seeks to be admitted to bail while this post-conviction relief (PCR) case is pending review. The State opposes the petition. Pursuant to Rule 243(k) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the petition is granted and Respondent shall be released from custody upon the following conditions:

- (1) Respondent will surrender to the Sheriff of Newberry County immediately upon the filing of an order dismissing this appellate case or an opinion in this matter;
- (2) Respondent will comply with all orders issued by this Court;
- (3) Respondent will not depart the State of South Carolina without the permission of this Court;
- (4) Respondent will be of good behavior;
- (5) Respondent will be prohibited from applying for a passport and will surrender any current passport to the Newberry County Clerk of Court;
- (6) Unless traveling to or from work or performing services in connection with his employment, Respondent shall be in his residence by 10:00 p.m. every night and remain there until 6:00 a.m. each morning; and
- (7) Respondent shall not associate with or be in contact with any known felons.

Prior to his release, Respondent shall appear before a circuit court judge in Newberry County within fifteen days to acknowledge these conditions, determine Respondent's residence, and post bond. The Attorney General's Office shall arrange for and facilitate the hearing. The form and amount of the bond and type of surety thereon shall be determined and approved by the circuit court judge. The circuit court judge is authorized to add further conditions deemed appropriate. The recognizance shall be filed with the Newberry County Clerk of Court. Unless an emergency arises, any request for travel considerations or for a change of address shall not be made for ninety days.
