1. Please Amend the Notice of Appeal in the above mentioned case as follows: Change the Jon Jarrard, Jr listed as petitioner to Jon W. Jarrard, Sr. in the title and the first line.
2. Request that I be allowed to Proceed Pro Se in this appeal.
3. Due to the Coronavirus and other issues as listed below, Request that

My Sentence be Commuted to House arrest.

(a) I am 67 years old, will be 68 this year. This puts me in a high risk category for serious complications if I should get the coronavirus. I am a partially disabled 20 year Army veteran currently residing in the Veteran's Dorm at MacDougal Correctional Institution. The Warden here, Edsel Taylor and the staff here are doing a great job keeping the virus out of this institution, but I feel that it is just a matter of time before it will eventually get in here.

(b) I have been incarcerated ~~is~~ in SCDC since June of 2012. I am scheduled to max out my sentence in June of 2024. I have no disciplinary actions at all.

(c) Prior to my trial in 2012 I

was locked up for 9 months in  
Horry County and 3 months in  
Kershaw County awaiting trial.

(d) I currently have only limited  
access to the law library, there  
are 2 computers with access to  
Westlaw (this is for 600 inmates)  
The books in the law library  
are out of date and some have  
pages missing out of them. There  
is no way to print out items  
from westlaw, you have to hand  
write all information. I have no  
way to type, copy or print.  
Copies of handwritten documents  
are not permitted to be made (even  
legal documents) per SCDC policies.

4. In lieu of the above request that  
the remainder of my sentence be  
suspended and that I be released,  
my mother, Louise Jarrard, is  
91 years old, has fallen and broken

her Arm and hip, she really needs me to help take care of her, she is self quarantined to reduce her chances of getting the virus. My sister, Cindy sweet, is currently caring for her but is in poor health. My Nephew Daniel Leonard is trying to take care of both of them. My only other sibling Alan Jarrard is in a rehab center in Ga. from having several strokes.

Your consideration in this matter would be greatly appreciated.
