To an honorable Judge,

I, Kelvin W Crosby am a part to a dishonest situation of greed and manipulation by my own sister, Rose Walsh. Of a \$1,116,000 million dollar estate I have received \$147K of which the remainder of \$132K I will never see only a small part of it in my lifetime. I just can't try to not be heard.

As a veteran serving my country and becoming service connected, with a 70% rating, then 100% individual unemployability since my diagnosis in 1998 I, Kelvin W Crosby am Petitioning the Court for a redress of grievances against my sister Rose Walsh, and her legal counsel.

I was the heir that saw fit in 2009 before moving to North Carolina that my mother's affairs were in order, her will was made to my deceased grandmother. I took my mother then in the early stages of Parkinson's disease to an attorney and waited in the waiting area as she did as her wishes were for all her property and assets. It did not bother me what she did with those assets as my concern was only that she would have a legitimate will. My sister, Rose Walsh at that time even made the comment that someone should have been with her in the room as she was not cognitive to do so. It was her right as my mother to do as she desired and I honored that.

This entire situation I have had to watch and read and anguish, undue stress to not only my wife and myself but to my two children both to be in college this year. It took such a toll on me that I was to such extreme depression that I was to the point of suicide years back by it. My medical records reflect this history for over three years now with the Department of Veteran's Affairs. That the harm by my sister with untrue statements, false answers under oath, and abusing her powers as the PR. Your honor this is a travesty of law and a disgrace that through the manipulation with high priced attorney's you have the resources to overcome someone as myself who can't afford an attorney, my sister has three. I decided it was time to dismiss my two attorney's and deal with this on my own in a truthful honorable manner. I could use this money to help my family and children and not line the pockets of attorney's by using the law to their advantage.

My mother died November 29, 2016 and this is going into its fourth year. There is no call for this to be as it is being done by a person of untrue moral fiber and character. I ask only that the truth be brought to light. And your honor this does effect me financially by losing a large portion of my rightful inheritance. My mother did not want this way.

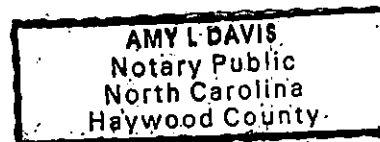

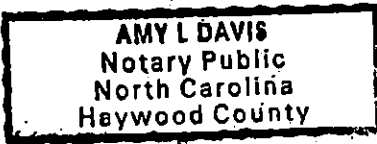

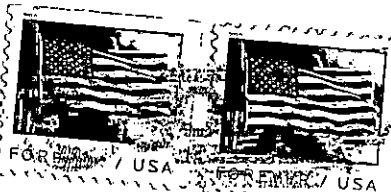
