The Appellant-Respondent served a notice of appeal from the final judgment on February 11, 2020. On February 17, 2020, the Respondent-Appellant TW Telecom served a notice of cross appeal from certain interlocutory orders. Pursuant to Rule 207, SCACR, the Respondent-Appellant had ten days to order any necessary transcripts for its cross appeal, but prior to the expiration of that ten-day period, the Court *sua sponte* dismissed the cross appeal by order of February 25, 2020. On February 28, 2020, the Respondent-Appellant served a Petition for Rehearing of the dismissal, and even though the cross appeal was dismissed, the Respondent-Appellant went ahead and sent letters to three court reporters ordering hearings transcripts relevant to the issues raised in both the primary and cross appeals. Copies of the correspondence with the court reporters were sent the Court of Appeals as evidenced on the C-Track database.

On May 22, 2020, the Court issued an order reinstating the cross appeal. In its cover letter, the Court requested a report on the status of the transcripts within 10 days which was automatically extended for 20 days by operation of the Supreme Court's Coronavirus Emergency order of March 20, 2020; accordingly, that response is due today, Monday, June 22, 2020 (since June 21, 2020 was a Sunday). The Respondent-Appellant hereby submits this letter together with the certificates from the court reporters to show unto this Court that following timeline:

1. The transcript for the trial held on January 31, 2019, was ordered, and already had been transcribed on February 10, 2019, prior to the filing of final judgment.
2. The transcript for the trial held on December 3, 2019, was ordered by this Respondent-Appellant on February 28, 2020, and transcribed by the court reporter on March 16, 2020.

3. The transcript for a hearing held on June 24, 2015, was ordered on February 28, 2020, and transcribed by the court reporter on April 4, 2020.
4. The transcript for a hearing held on September 6, 2017, was ordered on February 28, 2020, and transcribed by the court reporter on April 20, 2020.
