COMES, John D. Alexander, Appellant above with a Second Motion To Proceed In Forma Pauperis in response to the June 2, 2020 Order of Honorable Jenny Abbott Kitching's demanding Appellant to pay in the amount of \$250.00 notice of appeal filing fee or face dismissal of this appeal and will show:

On March 13, 2020 the Appellant submitted his first Motion To Proceed In Forma Pauperis before the South Carolina Court of Appeals. At that time the Appellant demonstrated that

he was indigent and a pauper due to never being paid by the South Carolina Department of Corrections for his labor over the past thirteen (13) years. At present the SCDC has not reconsidered paying the Appellant for past and current labors,

Consequently, the Appellant is unable to do the impossible i.e., produce \$250.00 to pay the filing fee. As a last result, the Appellant does consent to having his E. H. Cooper Trust Fund Account garnished for the full amount of the filing fee whenever the SCDC decides to pay him for his labor.
