**JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLIES
IN SUPPORT OF PETITIONS FOR REHEARING**

Respondents South Carolina Ports Authority (Ports Authority) and South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) (collectively Respondents) respectfully and jointly move the Court for an extension of time to file their respective Replies to the Return of the Petitioners and in Support of their Petitions for Rehearing pursuant to Rules 221(a), 240, and 263(b) SCACR. In support of this Motion, Respondents state as follows:

1. This Court filed a published opinion in the above-captioned matter, Opinion No. 27949, on February 19, 2020, reversing and remanding the matter to the Administrative Law Court.

2. On April 27, 2020, Respondents timely filed their respective Petitions for Rehearing of the Court's Opinion.

3. On June 26, 2020, Petitioners filed a joint Return by U.S. Mail, which has not yet been received.

4. Under Rule 240, SCACR, any Reply to the Return is due to be filed on Monday, July 6, 2020.

5. Due to time constraints for personal and work obligations conflicting with the current deadline, which also coincides with a Holiday weekend, counsel for Respondents Ports Authority and DHEC respectfully and jointly request an extension of an additional five (5) days to file their respective Replies to the Return and in support of their Petitions for Rehearing.

6. If the Court grants this request, the undersigned calculates that the Replies will be due on Monday, July 13, 2020.


7. Counsel for the Respondents have consulted with Counsel for the Petitioners, and the undersigned is authorized to state that Petitioners consent to the granting of this request.
