
Re: The State v. Michael Ed Blandon Childs – Appellate Case No. 2020-000178

On February 7, 2020, we mailed an affidavit of indigency to trial counsel, Mr. E. Delane Rosemond, for Mr. Childs to complete and return to our office by February 21, 2020. We understand Mr. Rosemond has attempted on several occasions to get Mr. Childs to return the indigency affidavit so that we could screen him.
