This is my pro se response to the petition filed by my counsel. I was sentenced to a non-violent plea of ten years, which is indicated on my sentencing sheet. Non-violent offenders are to serve 65% of the time of the sentence. I accepted this plea because of this matter. While being incarcerated, I was told I would have to do 85% of my time. If I would have known this, I may have not accepted the plea deal. My counsel was ineffective in relaying this important information. I am a veteran that served 2 years in Iraq. I love and believe everything this country stands for. I have faith that someone will take the time to consider my situation and correct this. I signed this plea deal because I would be parole-eligible and receive work credits. This has not been the case. If I had known this, I may have went to trial. I am asking the Court to amend my sentence to a non-violent 65% sentence. This is indicated on my sentence sheet. I have enclosed a copy of my sentence sheet. As we all know COVID 19 is impacting the world and has now entered the prison system, which is a major concern to me considering my release date is suppose to be April of 2021. I am just asking that the Supreme Court fix this matter.
