ORDER

First, Respondents' motion to strike the record on appeal is granted. Appellant's supplemental record, filed May 20, 2020, is also stricken. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal that includes only those matters that were specifically included in the parties' designation of matter. Appellant shall not include any other documents in the record on appeal.

Second, Respondents' motion to strike Appellant's initial reply brief is granted. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended initial reply brief that (1) does not include new issues on appeal, and (2) provides proper citation to authorities to support the salient facts alleged. *See* Rule 208(b)(4), SCACR. Respondents' motion to file a sur-reply brief is denied.

Third, the motion to relieve counsel for Respondents is granted. Attorneys Burl Franklin Williams and William George Newsome, III are relieved as counsel for Respondents. Attorneys J. David Black and Kirsten Elena Small shall continue as counsel for Respondents.
