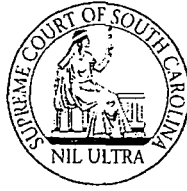

This Court has received your petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix seeking review of the South Carolina Court of Appeals decision to dismiss the appeal in Appellate Case No. 2012-212017.
