RETURN TO MOTION TO
SUPPLEMENT DESIGNATION

3. The Appellate Court Rules provide a measured sequence of steps in perfecting the appeal. After the appellant designates the material desired for inclusion in the Record on Appeal, the respondent's brief is written in the context of the material designated by the appellant, and to be designated by the respondent. The designated

material confines the brief.

4. This appeal is fully briefed. If the appellant's motion is granted, then respondent must ask permission to review the additional material and to revise the respondent's brief in light thereof, if necessary.


