ORDER

Respondent moves to strike portions of Section II of petitioner's brief on the basis that the brief contains arguments not argued to the Court of Appeals or in the petition for a writ of certiorari. In the alternative, respondent requests this Court withdraw the grant of certiorari as to Issue 2 in petitioner's petition for a writ of certiorari. Respondent further seeks a stay of the time to file its brief, and an extension of eight days from the time the Court addresses these motions to file its respondent's brief.

The motions to strike or withdraw the grant of certiorari are denied without prejudice to respondent's right to raise whether the arguments in petitioner's brief are properly before this Court in its respondent's brief. The motion to extend the time to file respondent's brief is granted and extended until July 22, 2020. The motion to stay is denied as moot.
