INTRODUCTION

This matter involves a motor vehicle accident that occurred on or about April 29, 2015 in Anson County, North Carolina. Plaintiff Daisy Frederick was a resident of Chesterfield County, South Carolina, and Defendant Daniel Lee McDowell was a resident of Marlboro County, South Carolina. The case was filed in Marlboro County on April 1, 2016 and came before this Court for trial on January 29, 2018. Because the collision occurred in North Carolina, this Court applied the North Carolina Rules of Evidence. The jury ultimately returned a verdict in favor of the Plaintiff in the amount of \$5,000,000.00 (five million dollars and zero cents).

On February 14, 2018, Defendant filed a number of post-trial motions. Namely, Plaintiff filed motions titled (1) Motion for Judgment Not Withstanding the Verdict; and (2) Motion for New Trial Absolute, "Thirteenth Juror," or New Trial Nisi Remittur. Defendant proceeded to file a supplemental brief in support of his motions on August 21, 2019.

CONCLUSION

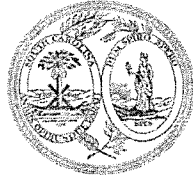
Defendant's post trial motions are respectfully **DENIED**.
