ORDER

Petitioner moves to reinstate the above appellate cases. He also moves to be released on a -personal recognizance or bail while these cases are resolved.

In Appellate Case Number Case No. 2016-002087, this Court denied a petition for a writ of certiorari to review an opinion of the South Carolina Court of Appeals. Subsequently, on August 11, 2017, the Court of Appeals sent the remittitur. Since the sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction, the motion to reinstate Appellate Case Number Case No. 2016-002087 is denied. *Stogsdill v. S.C. Dep't of Health & Human Servs.*, 415 S.C. 568, 784 S.E.2d 669 (2016) ("The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case, and no further motions will be entertained after the remittitur is sent.").

In Appellate Case Number 2018-000616, petitioner sought relief under Rule 245 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. By order dated May 9, 2018, this appellate case was dismissed under *Key v. Currie*, 305 S.C. 115, 406 S.E.2d 356 (1991). A petition for rehearing was filed, but that petition was stricken and dismissed as being untimely. In short, this appellate case has been fully resolved. Accordingly, the motion to reinstate Appellate Case Number 2018-000616 is denied.

Finally, the motion to be released on personal recognizance or bail is denied.
