





ALREADY ROLLED DOWN FROM STEWART DISCARDING CONTRABAND OUT OF THE WINDOW. IN THE DOOR HANDLE OF THE PASSENGER SIDE DOOR WAS RESIDUE OF A WHITE CRYSTAL LIKE SUBSTANCE. THIS WHITE CRYSTAL LIKE SUBSTANCE WAS ALSO FOUND IN THE FLOOR BOARD OF THE DRIVER'S SEAT. I ALSO DISCOVERED TWO STRAWS WHICH HAD RESIDUE OF THIS WHITE CRYSTAL LIKE SUBSTANCE INSIDE. THIS RESIDUE INSIDE OF THE VEHICLE FIELD TESTED PRESUMPTIVE POSITIVE FOR COCAINE.

A COMB SEARCH OF THE SHOULDER OF MYERS ROAD WAS CONDUCTED AND A LOADED .380 KBI PISTOL (9320435) WAS LOCATED AT 580 MYERS RD WHERE I RECOVERED IT ON THE SHOULDER. THIS WAS IN THE VICINITY WHERE STEWART HAD ORIGINALLY STOPPED HIS VEHICLE IN THE ROADWAY BEFORE MAKING A U-TURN ILLEGALLY. THE FIREARM HAD A ROUND CHAMBERED AND 5 OTHER ROUNDS IN THE MAGAZINE. AT 601 MYERS RD A PILL BOTTLE WAS LOCATED AT THE END OF THE DRIVEWAY, WHICH WAS THE SAME LOCATION THAT STEWART HAD STOPPED HIS VEHICLE FOR A BRIEF PERIOD AFTER MAKING THE U-TURN. INSIDE THE PILL BOTTLE WAS APPROXIMATELY 10.4 GRAMS OF A WHITE CRYSTAL LIKE SUBSTANCE AND 1.5 GRAMS OF A GREEN LEAFY SUBSTANCE. THE 10.4 GRAMS OF THE WHITE CRYSTAL LIKE SUBSTANCE THEN FIELD TESTED POSITIVE FOR CRACK COCAINE.

SCHP DISPATCH THEN RAN A CRIMINAL HISTORY ON STEWART AND IT WAS DETERMINED THAT STEWART WAS PROHIBITED TO POSSESS A FIREARM DUE TO HAVING PREVIOUS FELONY CHARGES. DISPATCH ALSO ADVISED THAT STEWART HAD FELONY WARRANTS OUT OF CHARLESTON COUNTY AS WELL.

STEWART WAS THEN ADVISED THAT HE WAS UNDER ARREST FOR DUS, DUI, SIMPLE P: MARIJUANA, TRAFFICKING CRACK/COCAINE, POSSESSION OF A FIRE BY A CONVICTED FELON AND UNLAWFUL CARRY OF A FIREARM.

STEWART WAS THEN TRANSPORTED TO HILL FINKLEA DETENTION CENTER WHERE I TOOK HIM INTO THE DATAMASTER ROOM WHERE I REQUESTED THAT HE SUBMIT A BREATH SAMPLE. STEWART WAS READ HIS IMPLIED CONSENT RIGHTS AND GIVEN HIS OWN COPY TO READ ALONG. STEWART THEN REFUSED TO SUBMIT A BREATH SAMPLE. STEWART WAS ISSUED A NOTICE OF SUSPENSION FOR HIS LICENSE FOR REFUSING TO SUBMIT A BREATH TEST.






