JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF BRIEFING DEADLINES

Appellant-Respondent Rigdon H. Boykin (“Rigdon”) and Respondent-Appellants Mary
Deas Wortley and Alice B. Belger (“Wortley and Belger”), jointly move the Court to extend by
thirty days the deadline for the filing of their responses to the Initial Briefs. As set forth below, the

Response Briefs are currently due on July 19, 2020, and granting this joint motion will make the Response Briefs due on or before Tuesday, August 18, 2020.

After the parties filed their Initial Briefs, Wortley and Belger filed a Motion to Strike on March 23, 2020, and sought an extension of time to respond to Rigdon's Initial Brief. This Court granted the requested extension by order dated April 10, 2020, providing an extension of time pending the motion to strike. On April 27, 2020, Rigdon sought the same extension this Court granted to Wortley and Belger, noting that such an extension would put the Response Briefs of both parties "on the same track." This Court granted Rigdon's requested extension by order dated May 7, 2020.

On May 22, 2020, this Court granted Wortley and Belger's Motion to Strike and required that Rigdon "serve and file his amended initial brief and designation of matter . . . within thirty days." Consistent with this Court's order, Rigdon served and filed his Amended Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on June 19, 2020. The Response Briefs of both sides are therefore currently due on July 19, 2020.

In this motion, Rigdon along with Wortley and Belger, jointly request a 30-day extension to file their Response Briefs, making them due on or before Tuesday, August 18, 2020. The only prior extension granted by this Court to the deadlines for the parties to provide their Response Briefs was in connection with the Motion to Strike. This additional extension is being sought to accommodate counsels' existing work commitments.
