

TO FILE IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Appellant, pro se, respectfully requests for a reconsideration to proceed in forma pauperis in the above-captioned case because of his poverish state, and due that he does not work for the prison industry private sector. The plant permanently closed down. In addition, he is not able to pay the \$250.00 filing fee because SCDC has impeded his 2019 state and federal tax refund payments, in which he has not received. Appellant was depending on those funds to pay his filing fee, but as of this date he has not received his state nor federal tax refunds. NOTE: His co-workers have all received their refunds 6 weeks ago. Also, Appellant was relying on the 2018 federal \$1200 stimulus payments, in which he was eligible and qualified for the same, but the prison officials returned the \$1200 payment to the IRS.

Based on the foregoing exceptional reasons, Appellant requests for reconsideration to proceed in forma pauperis.



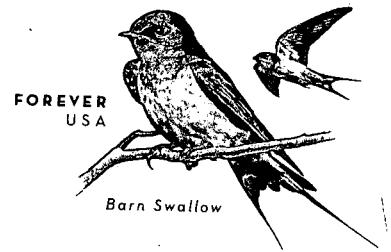
