ORDER

On May 20, 2020, the South Carolina Court of Appeals issued an opinion affirming the circuit court in this matter. *Windy Hill MHP, LLC, v. Holcombe*, Op. No. 2020-UP-149 (S.C. Ct. App. filed May 20, 2020). When no petition for rehearing was received, the Court of Appeals sent the remittitur on June 29, 2020. Petitioner has now filed a petition for a writ of certiorari dated June 24, 2020,¹ seeking review of the decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals in this matter.

Under Rule 242(a) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), this Court will only review a final decision of the Court of Appeals, and a decision is not final for the purposes of review until a petition for rehearing has been acted on by the Court of Appeals. Rule 242(c), SCACR. Since no petition for rehearing has been ruled on by the Court of Appeals in this matter, there is no final decision for this Court to review.

Further, when no petition for rehearing was received by the Court of Appeals, the Court of Appeals sent the remittitur. Rule 221, SCACR. The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007).

¹ The petition for a writ of certiorari was received by the South Carolina Court of Appeals on June 29, 2020, and the Court of Appeals forwarded the petition to this Court.

Accordingly, the petition for a writ of certiorari is dismissed.
