MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for John R.T. Wilson respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension, until August 26, 2020**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.

2. Counsel for John R.T. Wilson respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed an Anders brief of appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Thomas R. Marett with this Court on July 10, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Rodney Galimore v. State in the Supreme Court on July 1, 2020. Counsel filed a petition for rehearing in the case of The State v Christian Anthony Himes with this Court on June 25, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Wanda Jane Crumpton with this Court on June 24, 2020. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Derrick Lamont Wade v. State in the Supreme Court on June 18, 2020. Counsel filed the return to the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Patrick O'Neil McGowan with this Court on June 15, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Carlos Anthony Dennison with this Court on June 10, 2020. Counsel had oral argument before this Court in the case of Terrance L. Bland v. The State on June 3, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Alqi Dhimo v. State in the Supreme Court on May 29, 2020.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


