4. On June 23, 2020, opposing counsel, for the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of the general consent granted by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through July 31, 2020.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty-day extension until August 26, 2020** in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case. Counsel requests that the time limits for filing the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
