Appellant provides the following supplemental authorities pursuant to Rule 208(b)(7), SCACR, as they have come to the attention of Petitioner and are relevant as they provide authoritative and persuasive support regarding the issues he has advanced in this appeal. Petitioner cites the following:

Sullivan v State, 504 S.E.2d 110 (1998) - Defendant could be denied parole based on subsequent conviction for violent crime, even though crime for which he was previously convicted was not classified as a violent crime at time of prior conviction.

Appellant cites Sullivan seeking that this Court would consider and compare this ruling and logic in Sullivan. Albert Sullivan is associated with violent and non-violent, it is very significant as it discusses how a prior conviction which has been reclassified would be treated in a present situation.

Appellant should not be deemed ineligible to receive SNAP food stamp benefits based on a prior drug conviction which has been reclassified as a misdemeanor during the time petitioner applied for those benefits.

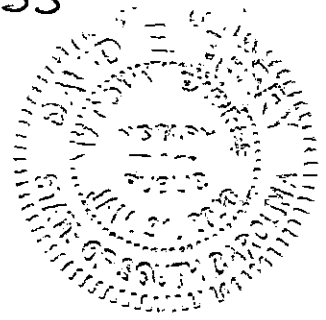


