**COUNT ONE**  
**STALKING**

That in Sumter County, South Carolina, on or about March 27, 2020, the Defendant, Robert James Pairman, intentionally through a pattern of words or conduct that served no legitimate purpose, did cause or did intend to cause the victim, Debra Watson, and would cause a reasonable person in Debra Watson's position to fear for herself or her family: death; assault; bodily injury; criminal sexual contact; kidnapping; or property damage; [said Defendant having been convicted of harassment or stalking within the previous ten years;] in violation of Section 16-3-1700 and Section 16-3-1730, Code of Laws of South Carolina, (1976) as amended.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
