

ORDER

Appellant has filed a notice of appeal from a memorandum of the Administrative Law Court Clerk's Office explaining that Appellant's appeal will not be processed unless it is accompanied by the appropriate filing fee. Because the memorandum is not a final order, appellate case number 2020-000995 is dismissed. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-610(A)(1) (Supp. 2019) (providing judicial review may only be sought from a final decision of the Administrative Law Court); *Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hosp. Auth. v. S.C. Dep't of Health & Envtl. Control*, 387 S.C. 265, 267, 692 S.E.2d 894 (2010) ("If there is some further act which must be done by the court prior to a determination of the rights of the parties, the order is interlocutory."). Remittitur will be sent pursuant to Rule 221(b), SCACR.
