
## ORDER

---

First, Respondent's motion to dismiss is denied.

Second, Appellant's motion for an extension of time to cure deficiencies in Appellant's designation of matter is granted. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended designation of matter that (1) includes a certification that the designation includes no matter that is irrelevant to the appeal; (2) the designation of matter is signed; and (3) the designation does not include any attachments or documents and only lists the materials proposed to be included in the record.

Third, Respondent's motion for an extension of time to serve and file Respondent's initial brief and designation of matter is granted. Respondent's initial brief and designation of matter shall be served and filed within thirty days of the date of this order.
