**Notice of Intent to Appeal**

The Appellant is in objection of the Administrative Law Court’s final order filed on Dec. 04, 2019, concerning case no. 19-ALJ-15-0033-AP. The Administrative Law Court admitted its inability to review the full scope of SCDPPP’s decision making process. A process that does fall under S.C. Codes of law §24-22-30 and SCDC policy PS 10.17 signed into law. On May 21, 2018, this policy was in fact abrogated to fit new agency standard updates. The Offender Management System is the *gold standard* in which the parole agencies base their decision. The Appellant did indeed match these standards with a vigorous approach, in his wanting to change and overcome the inner faults that plagued him some 33 years ago. By challenging himself to adhere to the standard set forth by the Department of Corrections; the Appellant is flabbergasted by the Parole Board recent denial of his release. 
