
RE: State v. Julio Andres Castillo; Appellate Case No.: 2019-001983

I will look forward to a response and/or guidance on this matter.

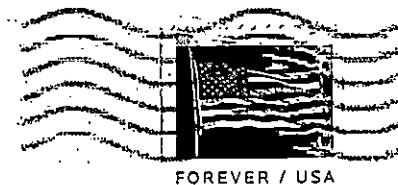
