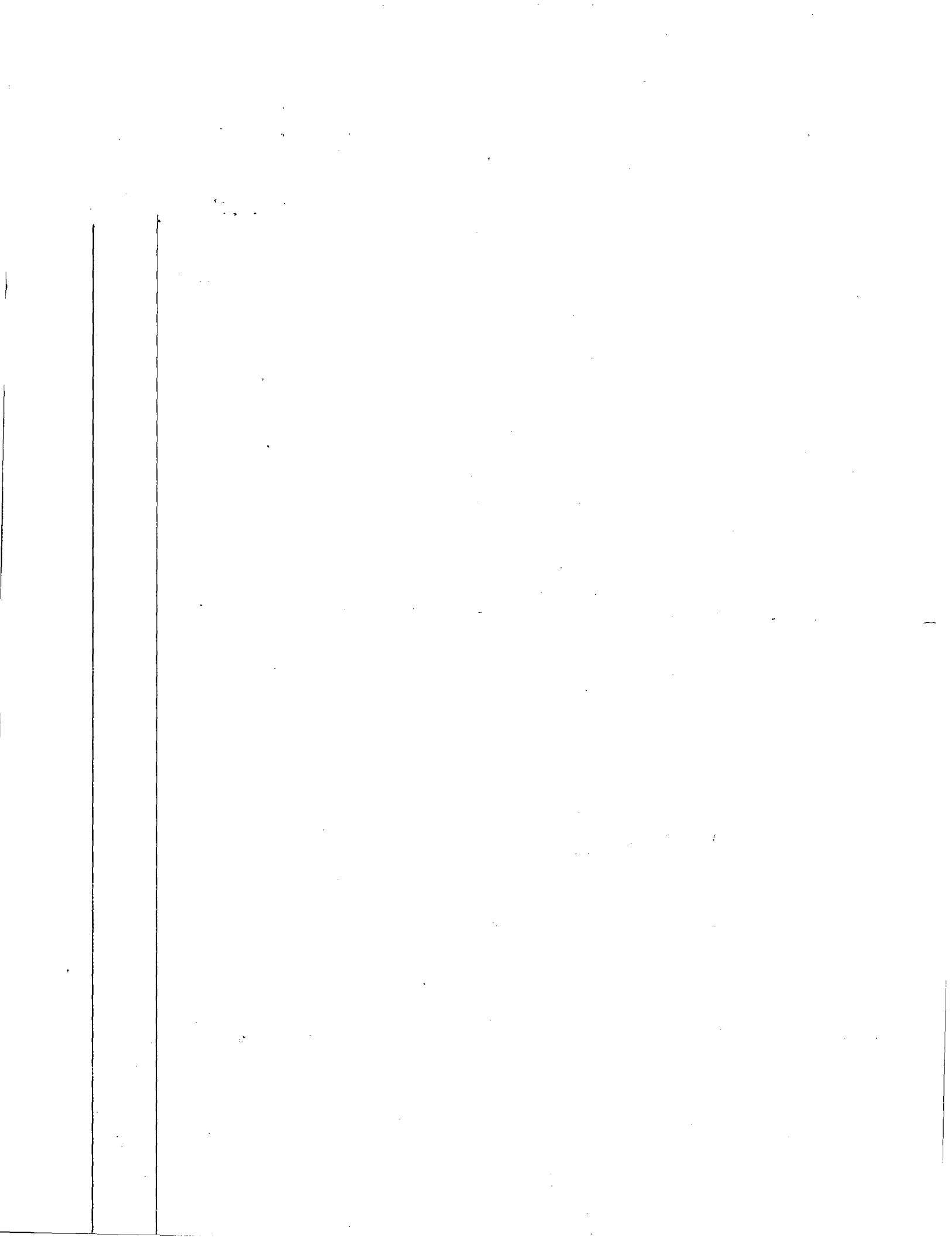
REQUEST FOR EXTENTION IN FILING
