**MOTION TO HOLD APPEAL IN ABEYANCE
WHILE COUNSEL OBTAINS NECESSARY TRANSCRIPTS**

Respondent, through its undersigned counsel, would respectfully show unto this Court as follows:

I.

The State received service of Appellant's Initial Brief of Appellant on July 22, 2020. After review, and when attempting to obtain the relevant and necessary transcripts related to the appeal, the State realized several transcripts had not been ordered by Appellant. The undersigned consulted with Appellant's counsel, who has graciously agreed to order the required transcripts, and it is the undersigned's belief that he has ordered all necessary transcripts from the court reporters.

II.

As a result of the need for the additional transcripts, the State asks this Court to hold the appeal in abeyance until the court reporters are able to complete copies of the transcripts for


Appellant and the State is also able to obtain copies of the transcripts. As soon as the court reporters have indicated the transcripts are complete and ready for Appellant's counsel, the State will order the transcripts so that there is minimal delay in the proceeding of the appeal. The State asks that all deadlines be held in abeyance until the State is able to obtain copies of the transcript and then to set the time for service and filing of the State's Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter for thirty days from receipt of the transcripts. Appellant's counsel has indicated his consent to holding the appeal in abeyance pending the court reporter completing the transcripts.

WHEREFORE, Respondent respectfully requests the Court hold this appeal and all deadlines in abeyance to allow the parties to obtain relevant and necessary transcripts. The State asks this Court to set the time for service and filing of the State's Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter for thirty days from the date the State receives copies of the necessary transcripts.
