MOTION TO STAY OF TIME LIMIT

Pursuant to Rule 240(b) SCACR, Appellant requests a stay of time limit to file his reply brief in this matter, 1) Due to Appellant's motion to dismiss, motion to object not having been responded to as of yet, and 2) At current, the Covid-19 crisis has Evers Correctional Institution on a lockdown status. any aspect of this case. Appellant is limited to personal books he has in his cell which are inadequate and rudimentary at best.




