SUBJECT: COVID-19 Suspension of Institutional Activities
DATE: July 28, 2020

During this unusual time of coping with the COVID-19 virus, ~~SCDC's goal is take the necessary precautions to limit the introduction of the virus into our institutions?~~ South Carolina Department of Corrections is returning employees back to work in phases and continuing to limit the movement of inmates inside our institutions or in the community. But keeping the regular movement inside our institutions as normal as possible. This includes but is not limited to recreation, showers, canteen, programs, education, etc. as much as possible.

SCDC is extending the suspension of the following activities statewide through August 31, 2020.

- All volunteer activities
- All Institutional tours
- Inmate Visitation – Due to the suspension of visitation, SCDC is allowing all inmates 2 free 5-minute phones calls per week. Even those inmates on telephone restriction or in RHU.
- All on site DEW presentations
- Work Release and Labor Crews
- All “routine” transfers – Transfers from CSU, GPH, Wellpath or for security reasons will continue. Any question concerning transfers, please contact the Office of the Deputy Director for Operations.
- Court transports to include PCR Court - Inmates will be made available via teleconferencing platforms.
- Parole hearings will be conducted via video conferring with SCDPPPS.

All above suspensions will be reassessed in 30 days.

SCDC has also suspended receiving of all new male inmates at Lieber R&E and Kirkland R&E until further notice.


Dear Ms. Kitchings;

I received a letter from you in regards to my filing of appeal from the ALC. The letter stated that you would dismiss the case if I didn't correct two things, 1.) proof of service, and 2.) filing fee.

I would like to bring to your attention the fact that the Law Library is the only location within my institution that provides any access to the Rules of Procedure in filing with your Court. At the present time my institution's law library is closed due to Covid-19 and the quarantine placed upon the whole institution. As a result of this I do not have access to any rules or case law. I filed this notice of appeal in the time frame of thirty days from receipt of Order issued from the ALC. I had to go upon what I was able to remember in filing this documentation. Presently due to staff shortages, caused by Covid-19, I will not have access to any Law Library services at my present institution for at least another month. See attached memorandum issued. Due to this I am asking for relaxing the rules of conformity with format. I filed the proof of service and served the ALC and the Court. Out of an abundance of caution I am enclosing another proof of service and serving opposing counsel as well.

I would like to also inform you that I have sent the filing fee as required. I requested a money order for payment with my institutional mailroom the same day I sent your office the Notice of Appeal. I can't make, force, or compel the institution or the DOC to send this money order in ten days. I have done all that is allowed of me in the present circumstances. I would ask for your office to allow for a delay to let the money order be processed within SCDC so this will not be a problem. I have confirmed with staff that the request has been processed.

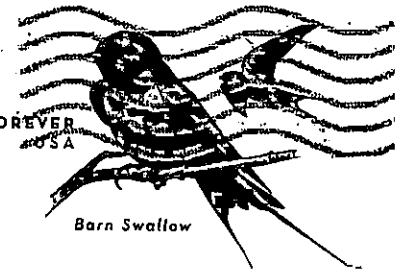
