ORDER

The State has filed a motion to exceed the page limit set forth in Rule 243(f), SCACR, for returns to petitions for writs of certiorari. Petitioner has not filed a response to the State's motion. The motion is denied. The State shall, within fifteen (15) days of the date of this order, serve and file an amended return that is within the page limit.

The State has also filed a motion to strike from Petitioner's petition for a writ of certiorari a reference to an alleged sanctioning of Petitioner's PCR counsel by the Office of Disciplinary Counsel (ODC). The motion to strike is granted. Petitioner shall strike from his petition any reference to ODC's alleged sanctioning of trial counsel. Petitioner shall have fifteen (15) days from the date of this order to serve and file an amended petition for a writ of certiorari deleting this reference.
