
Motion TO Verify Case Numbers

The above Appellate filed (2) Notice of Appeals from the Administrative Law Court, which were denied by The Honorable Judge Deborah Brooks Darden on October 3, 2012. One was for Threatening to Inflict Harm on/Assaulting an Employee and/or Members of the Public (809) ALC Docket No. 12-ALJ-04-0044-AP and S.C.D.C. Grievance No. RCI 0101-11. The other was a Damage, Loss, Destruction, or Defacing of Property Valued at Less than \$100.00 (856) ALC Docket No. 12-ALJ-04-0025-AP and S.C.D.C. Grievance No. RCI 0079-11.

Both Notice of Appeals were filed on the same day. On December 4, 2012 Appellant received several orders from this court stating "Appellate Case No. 2012-213396 (7) and Appellate Case No. 2012-213434 (8)." But the courts did not explain or verify which case numbers applied to each other. For this reason Appellant cannot file his briefs because he doesn't know which case numbers apply to each other. He has sent (2) two letters to this court about this, and they have fail to respond.
