ORDER

This appeal arises out of the Administrative Law Court's order vacating the South Carolina Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services' decision and remanding to the Department. Because the underlying order is not final, this appeal is dismissed. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-610(A)(1) (Supp. 2019) (providing judicial review may only be sought from a final decision of the Administrative Law Court); *Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hosp. Auth. v. S.C. Dep't of Health & Env'tl. Control*, 387 S.C. 265, 267, 692 S.E.2d 894 (2010) ("If there is some further act which must be done by the court prior to a determination of the rights of the parties, the order is interlocutory."). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
