Ms. Allen,

The Court asked me to try and obtain State's Exhibit 18 in a format easily playable on computers. The interview was recorded through a system which utilizes a proprietary format for recording. Accordingly, there is a player that should be on the same disk as the video file which is used to play the video file. Based on numerous conversations with my IT staff and others, there is no means of converting the file to an mp4 or other popular file format for easy playback. The only means of playing the file is through the video player included as an EXE file with the video. Would you verify that the disk delivered to the Court has both CH05_000.DVR which is the video file for the interview and PLAYBACK.EXE which is the installation program for the player necessary to view the video file? If not, I can deliver a new disk to the Court which is known to contain both the video and program. I am terribly sorry for the inconvenience being caused, but it all stems from the system used in recording the video initially, and as stated, there does not appear to be any way to convert the file. I am also notifying opposing counsel, Susan Hackett, of what I have learned and the status of the State's attempt to provide the Court a converted file.
