MOTION FOR AN ADDITIONAL EXTENSION TIME

---

Lemore Young, the Appellate, by and through his undersigned counsel, and due to extraordinary circumstances, herby moves for and additional extension of time to serve and file the Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter. This Court's May 7, 2020 order held the appeal in abeyance for sixty days pending the appointment of a personal representative for the deceased Appellant's estate. An additional extension was granted until August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020. That date is quickly approaching and due to additional unforeseen and extenuating circumstances, an additional extension of time is needed to accomplish getting Mr. Young's wife, Janice Young, appointed as his personal representative.

The additional delay in Mrs. Young's appointment has occurred as a result of her having the daunting task of arranging for multiple children to sign the appropriate Probate Court

documents allowing her to pursue being appointed as the personal representative of her husband's estate. Some of the children are not local and arrangements needed to be made in order to obtain their signatures. Due to COVID-19 restrictions and complicated logistics, there were some additional delays.

On Friday August 14, 2020, Mrs. Young's application for appointment as the Personal Representative of her husband's estate was filed with Greenville County Probate Court. Counsel for the Appellant spoke with representatives at Probate Court and requested that the appointment be expedited, as the decedent has a case is pending before this Court. Counsel was ensured that efforts would be made to "fast track" Mrs. Young's process of appointment but was not given an anticipated date of completion. Mrs. Young's appointment is at the discretion of Greenville County Probate Court, rendering it nearly impossible to anticipate what length of extension will be needed.

Therefore, for the foregoing reasons, and pursuant to Rule 263, SCACR, the undersigned counsel moves for an additional extension of time. Undersigned counsel moves for an additional thirty (30) day extension and requests that should any additional unforeseen delays occur in Probate Court, that this Court would further extend the deadline or hold this case in abeyance until those issues can be resolved.
