
MOTION FOR EXTENTION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY IN SUPPORT OF PETITION FOR CERTIORARI

Pursuant to Rules 240 and 263 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), Petitioners Preservation Society of Charleston, Historic Charleston Foundation, Historic Ansonborough Neighborhood Association, South Carolina Coastal Conservation League, Charlestowne Neighborhood Association, Charleston Chapter of the Surfrider Foundation, and Charleston Communities for Cruise Control (Petitioners) move the Court for an extension of time to file a Consolidated Reply in Support of its Petition for Certiorari.

1. On January 29, 2018, Petitioners timely filed their Petition for Writ of Certiorari in this matter.
2. On February 28, 2018, Respondent South Carolina State Ports Authority (SPA) filed its Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals.

3. On February 26, 2018, Respondent South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) filed Respondent SCDHEC's Motion for Extension of Time to File Respondent's Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari, requesting an extension of thirty (30) days to file its Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari.
4. On March 2, 2018, the Court partially granted SCDHEC's request for an extension, extending SCDHEC's filing deadline for its Return until March 15, 2018.
5. In light of SCDHEC's new filing deadline, Petitioners request fifteen (15) days additional time to file a consolidated reply to both SPA and SCDHEC's Returns, such deadline to be calculated from the date of SCDHEC's actual filing.
6. This extension is requested because Petitioners' counsel are involved in several additional matters that require significant attention of Petitioners' counsel, including pending responsive briefing due in federal court during the period that Petitioners would, in the absence of the requested extension, also need to prepare their Reply to SCDHEC's Return. Petitioners also seek to file a consolidated reply to SPA's and SCDHEC's separate returns, reducing the burden on the Court.
7. Petitioners respectfully moves this Court for an Order extending the time for filing Petitioners' Consolidated Reply in Support of its Petition for Writ of Certiorari until ^{ten 10} ~~twenty-five (25)~~ days after SCDHEC files its Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari. Petitioners respectfully request that all other deadlines be held in abeyance pending the Court's approval of this extension.


